- ❖ The committee shall be responsible for causality assessment of each Adverse Event/Case reported from their respective AMC/Peripheral Hospitals.
- ❖ The CAC shall meet at least twice in a month to do the causality of each Adverse Event/Case reported from their AMC/Peripheral Hospitals.
- ❖ After the causality assessment, Coordinator and Technical Associate shall be responsible to submit the reports to NCC-PVFI and in case of Serious Adverse Events (SAE) not later than 15 days.
- ❖ Tenure of the CAC shall be for the period of three years.
